Procedure:

Infringement proceedings are initiated, inter alia, through a complaint. The complaint may be made in writing by any person or body.

The report must include a description of the place and date of the offense, the circumstances of the offense, the means of proof and the known personal data of the person subject to the proceedings. If possible, the means of proof must be attached to the complaint.

As a general offense authority, the bodies set up by the police to carry out general police tasks are designated as offense authorities.

The ANYK form (hereafter referred to as "the Form") is intended to provide a facility for public space supervisors to file a report of an offense against a known person to the competent police offense authorities.

The report shall be sent to the police authorities responsible for the place where the offense was committed.

The form contains structured fields which, when properly filled in, will ensure that the infringement report is automatically submitted to the authority competent to conduct the proceeding.

In order to ensure efficient administration, it is important that the form is completed and submitted on a case-by-case basis.

Any number of attachments (but at least 1) can be attached to the case, up to a maximum size limit of 300 MB for forms.
